PCLS reserves the right to monitor content and remove messages or postings containing the following

- Comments containing hate language, vulgar, obscene, or libelous language
- Degrading content directed at others on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, socioeconomic status, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation, or national origin
- Personal attacks against others
- Threatening or harassing postings
- False information
- Copyright violations
- Off topic comments
- Duplicated posts from the same individual
- Endorsements of specific products or services for advertising purposes.
